Time commitment for Board members

Thinking of nominating for the Veterinary Surgeons' Board?

Below is a summary of the time commitment for Board members. A substantially greater time commitment is required by the Chair of the Board.

Item	How Often	Time commitment
Board Meetings	Minimum 12 per year	Thursdays 7am-12pm Average of five hours per month
Read Agenda	Minimum 12 per year	3-4 hours per month
Read and respond to emails	Several times a week	2-4 hours per week
Attend mediations or meetings with stakeholders	Zero to six per year	Half a day to a full day each
Comment on policies, protocols, procedures, guidelines or other documentation.	One or two per week	Two to four hours per week

Please ensure that if you agree to nominate for election to the Board, you are willing and able to fulfil the above time commitment. Reasonable expenses are covered by the Board and a modest remuneration given for each meeting attended.
